
## Summer Reading, 2023 - 2024 - Rising 7th Graders

We are excited to have you in class next school year! Please read the following directions and complete the Summer Reading requirements to ensure that you will be prepared for next school year:

- 1. All rising 7th graders will read the novel, *Hush* by Jacqueline Woodson (as seen above). In addition to being written by an award winning author, *Hush* is a novel embedded in our district approved curriculum. This novel should be read over the summer. Students **MUST** be finished reading *Hush* by September 1st, 2023. On this date, we will take a comprehension test over the book **FOR A GRADE**. You must be finished reading *Hush* to have success.
- In addition to a comprehension test, students MUST complete a book review (found on the back of this sheet). This book review WILL be taken for a grade as well. It will be due September 1st.

Note: *Hush* may be purchased at Amazon, Barnes and Noble, or any book retailer. Additionally, students may borrow the book from a public library.
